

ORDER IMPOSING A SALES TAX IN CALDWELL COUNTY, MISSOURI, AT THE RATE OF ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT.

WHEREAS, Caldwell County, Missouri (the "County"), is authorized under Section 644.032, RSMo (the "Act"), to impose a sales tax on all retail sales made in the County which are subject to taxation under the provisions of Section 144.010 to 144.525, RSMo, for the purpose of providing funding for the construction of a lake in the Little Otter Creek watershed as a storm water control and park project of the County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to an Order of the County Commission of May 23, 2002 (the "Order"), the County Commission ordered a special election to be held in the County on August 6, 2002, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City the following question:

QUESTION

Shall the County Commission of Caldwell County, Missouri, be authorized to impose a county-wide sales tax in the amount of one-half of one percent for the purpose of providing funding for the construction of a lake in the Little Otter Creek watershed as a storm water control and park project of the County?

- **Section 1.** With the approval on August 6, 2002 by a majority of the qualified voters voting thereon of the above-referenced question, the County Commission hereby authorizes the imposition of a sales tax at the rate of one-half of one percent for the purpose of providing funding for the construction of a lake in the Little Otter Creek watershed as a storm water control and park project of the County.
- Section 2. The County Clerk is hereby ordered to forward to the Director of Revenue, by United States registered or certified mail, a certified copy of this Order and the May 23, 2002 Order and an abstract of votes cast on the question at the August 6, 2002 election not later than August 24, 2002. The sales tax imposed by this Order shall become effective on January 1, 2003, as provided by the Act, by Sections 32.085 and 32.087, RSMo., as amended, and by all other applicable laws, and shall be used for the purposes hereinabove authorized.
