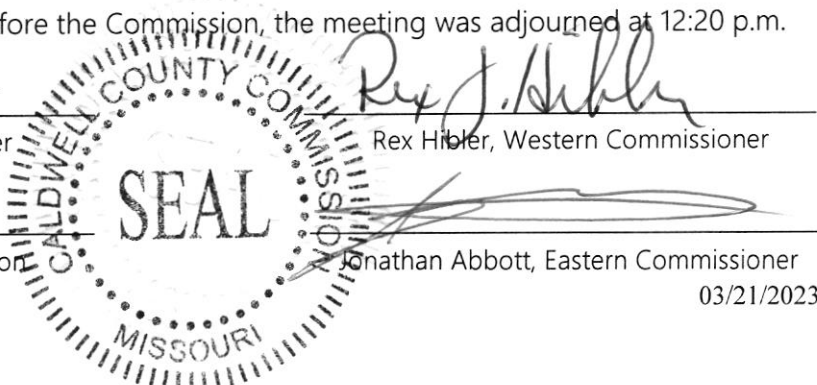
Beth Larkins, County Treasurer/Collector reported that she would be sending the Collectors Annual Settlement, Form 205, to the State.

Commissioners returned Allison Ham’s phone call concerning Grain Belt crossing next to her property.


6. ADJOURNMENT


With no other business before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned at 12:20 p.m.
