1. CALL TO ORDER

Commissioner Dale Akey called the meeting to order at 8:30 A.M.

Commissioners met with Terry Rumery to discuss Economic Development in the county.

Brady Kopek, Prosecuting Attorney met with the commissioners to discuss modifications to a sewage ordinance they are considering putting in place.


Commissioners returned a call from Pat Daniels about the recording of a previous Commission meetings.
