Commissioners met with Larry Chipman, ARPA Coordinator, to discuss ARPA applications. Commissioners approved applications #43, #44, and #45.


Commissioners called Tony Figg with Greenhills Communications to discuss the IT transition.

ADJOURNMENT


With no other business before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned at 12:50 p.m.




