

NOTABLE DATES OF INTEREST TO VOTERS
(February 20, 2024 Through April 4, 2024)

February 20th – Absentee Voting for the April 2, 2024 election begins.

February 27th – First day to file as a candidate for the August 6, 2024 Primary Election.

March 6th – Last day to Register to Vote in the April 2, 2024 election. The Caldwell County Clerk's Office will be open until 5:00 p.m. to register individuals. A government-issued ID and proof of residency is required.

March 20th – Last day to request an Absentee Ballot by mail. (Application must be received in the County Clerk's Office by this date.)

March 21st – The County Clerk's Office will begin pre-testing the voting equipment beginning at 10:00 a.m. and will continue until all the machines have been tested. The public is invited and encouraged to attend. Testing will be held at the courthouse.

March 22nd – Last day to file Declarations of Intent as a Write-In Candidate. Paperwork will be accepted at the County Clerk's Office until 5:00 p.m. for the April 2, 2024 Municipal Election.

March 26th – Last day to file as a candidate for the August 6, 2024 Primary Election. The County Clerk's Office will be open until 5:00 p.m. to accept paperwork.

March 30th – The County Clerk's Office will be open 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for Absentee Voting.

April 2nd – Municipal Election Day

Only those who live within the Cameron School District and vote at the Gomer/Hamilton Polling Place located at the Methodist Church in Hamilton will have items to vote on in the April 2, 2024 election.

April 4th – The County Clerk's Office will begin post-testing the election equipment beginning at 10:00 a.m. and will continue until all the machines have been tested. The public is invited and encouraged to attend. Testing will be held at the courthouse.
