CALDWELL COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

Tuesday, May 27, 2025

1. CALL TO ORDER

Presiding Commissioner Akey called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Commissioner Akey will review before signing the grant agreement. Commissioners also discussed the 2025 budget for the Caldwell County Detention Center with Sheriff Allen.

Beth Larkins, Collector/Treasurer and Tracy Bowen with the Assessors office met with Commissioners to discuss Senior Tax Freeze Applications. Commissioners reviewed and signed applications.

The commission held a bid opening for Depository Bank Services. Renee Anderson with Bank Northwest was in attendance. One bid was received from Bank Northwest. The sealed bid was opened by Presiding Commissioner Akey and reviewed by the commission.
