CALDWELL COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

Tuesday, June 24, 2025

1. CALL TO ORDER

Presiding Commissioner Akey called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

4. AGENDA

Commissioner Hibler moved to approve the agenda. Commissioner Howell seconded the motion. Commissioner Hibler, Commissioner Akey and Commissioner Howell voted in favor. The motion passed.

Commissioner Hibler moved to approve the consent agenda. Commissioner Howell seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Akey-yes; Hibler-yes, Commissioner Howell-yes. The motion passed.

Jeff Campbell, Road & Bridge; Ezekiel Petterson, and Lindsey Chaffin with Great Rivers Engineering met with the commission to discuss project updates. The county bridge replacement schedule was reviewed. Commissioner Howell moved to accept the bid from MS contracting for BRO-R013(42). Commissioner Hibler seconded the motion. Commissioner Akey-yes; Hibler-yes, Commissioner Howell-yes. The motion passed.

Commissioners signed a request for concurrence. Presiding Commissioner Akey signed a Flood Plain Permit for Lida Road. Presiding Commissioner Akey and Commissioner Howell signed an Engineering Service Contract for New York Road Bridge.

Notices for bridge closings and detour information for BRO-R013(001) NE Sandstone Drive bridge over NE Sandstone Creek and BRO-R013(002) SE Lida Road bridge over Mud Creek will be posted on the commission bulletin board in the courthouse. The bridge replacements are scheduled to begin in Summer 2026 with construction lasting approximately 90 days.

Sheriff Mitch Allen; Nicole Lund, Sheriffs Office; Rich Smith, CCDC; and Jessica Farmer, CCDC met with commissioners. Sheriff Allen reported they were working on an agreement with Clay County to house 15 to 20 inmates at \$100 per day and \$80 for transportation of inmates. Staffing numbers at CCDC were evaluated. Cyber Security was discussed. Commissioners asked Sheriff Allen to review security camera footage.

Commissioners called Attorney Ed Proctor concerning the contract on the Gordan Kinne property.


Commissioners reviewed and signed Senior Tax Freeze applications.


With no other business before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned at 11:55 a.m.
