CALDWELL COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

Tuesday, July 29, 2025

1. CALL TO ORDER

Presiding Commissioner Akey called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

4. AGENDA

Commissioner Hibler moved to approve the agenda. Commissioner Howell seconded the motion. Commissioner Hibler, Commissioner Howell, and Commissioner Akey voted in favor. The motion passed.

Commissioner Hibler moved to approve the consent agenda. Commissioner Howell seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Akey-yes; Hibler-yes; Commissioner Howell-yes. The motion passed.

Mark Merrill, Emergency Management Director, met with commissioners to report that he had been working on upgrading storm sirens. He informed the commission that the Emergency Management salary grant had expired, and he will reapply when the application period opens again. Mark said that MW Electric Supply, Inc. was able to get the cable for the generator. He also reported that cubicle walls had been obtained for the Caldwell County Detention Center.

The propane bid opening was held at 9:00 a.m. Steve Henry from Thompson Gas was in attendance. Four bids were received and opened: MFA Oil \$1.218 per gallon, Thompson Gas \$1.239 per gallon, Consumers Oil \$1.29 per gallon, and Ferrellgas \$1.35 per gallon. After reviewing all bids and calling MFA Oil to request clarification on the details included in their bid, the commission determined that MFA Oil submitted the lowest and best bid, based on price and service considerations.

Commissioner Hibler moved to accept the propane bid of \$1.218 per gallon from MFA Oil of Hamilton. Commissioner Howell seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Akey-yes; Hibler-yes; Commissioner Howell-yes. The motion passed. All companies who submitted a bid will be notified by County Clerk Jamy Aubrey of the outcome.

Stephanie Henry gave an update on the work that she has done since starting in her position as Planning & Zoning Coordinator.

Sheriff Mitch Allen and the Commission discussed costs for dispatch services as well as the Caldwell County Detention Center Medical Services.


