
Commissioners called Greg Pitchford with Allstate to discuss an indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity (IDIQ) contract for Little Otter Creek.


The Commissioners met with Ashley McNew with the License Office to discuss office security.

Commissioners spoke to Stephanie Henry, Planning & Zoning Director concerning the process to issue permits and houses requiring building permits.


ADJOURNMENT
