CALDWELL COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

Tuesday, September 23, 2025

1. CALL TO ORDER

Presiding Commissioner Akey called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

4. AGENDA

Commissioner Hibler moved to approve the agenda. Commissioner Howell seconded the motion. Commissioner Hibler, Commissioner Howell, and Commissioner Akey voted in favor. The motion passed.

Commissioner Howell moved to approve the consent agenda. Commissioner Hibler seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Akey-yes; Commissioner Hibler-yes; Commissioner Howell-yes. The motion passed.

Commissioners reviewed, approved, and signed the weekly invoices, authorizing them for payment.

Commissioners reviewed the \$450 invoice for 2026 dues for the National Association of Counties and determined that they would not renew the membership.

Jeff Campbell, Road & Bridge Supervisor, reported that contractors had been mobilized and would soon be starting construction on Dillon and James bridges. He noted that the tube project on Washington had been completed and that a larger tube had been ordered for Jackson Road. Jeff and the Commissioners discussed obtaining diesel pricing for the Road & Bridge Department. He also reported receiving a road crossing map for the new pipeline and presented an example agreement for Livingston County for review.


Commissioners reviewed the 2025 inventory list for Planning & Zoning that was submitted by Stephanie Henry, Planning & Zoning Administrator.



With no other business before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned at 10:20 a.m.




