1. CALL TO ORDER

Commissioner Howell moved to approve the agenda. Commissioner Akey seconded the motion. Commissioner Howell and Commissioner Akey voted in favor. The motion passed.

Mitch Allen, Sheriff, Jessica Farmer and Rich Smith of the Caldwell County Detention Center met with the commission to provide updates on CCDC. It was reported that they were negotiating a contract with Clay County to house inmates.

Greg Pitchford with Allstate met with the commission to discuss the process for Requests for Quotes (RFQ) for prescribed burning and invasive species control for the care of native pollinator habitat, and forest management at Little Otter Creek. All RFQ's are due and will be reviewed at next week's Commission meeting on Tuesday, September 09, 2025.

Michael Marriott with MODOT presented commissioners with a five-year Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) plan for Caldwell County.


Beth Larkins, Collector/Treasurer, presented a list of fourth-year offerings from the tax sale with loss of revenue amounts for each entity.




With no other business before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned at 12:05 p.m.




