### **CALDWELL COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING**

Wednesday, November 12, 2025

#### **CALL TO ORDER**

Commissioner Hibler called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

On Tuesday, November 11<sup>th</sup>, the courthouse was closed in observance of Veteran's Day.

Commissioner Hibler moved to approve the agenda. Commissioner Howell seconded the motion. Commissioner Hibler and Commissioner Howell voted in favor. The motion passed.

Commissioner Howell moved to approve the consent agenda. Commissioner Hibler seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Hibler-yes; Commissioner Howell-yes. The motion passed.

Commissioners reviewed, approved, and signed the weekly invoices, authorizing them for payment.

Presiding Commissioner joined the meeting by phone at 8:25 a.m.

Commissioners met with Adam Thomas to address questions regarding courthouse repair projects currently out for bid.

Sheriff Mitch Allen and Jessica Farmer of Caldwell County Detention Center discussed the contract to increase inmate per diem rates with the U.S. Marshals Service as well as the attorney fees required to complete that process. Commissioner Howell signed a Federal IGA Solutions agreement authorizing the attorney to proceed with the renegotiation of the county's contract with the U.S. Marshals Service regarding the housing of federal inmates. Sheriff Allen also reported that he has hired a new deputy.



The Commission advised that they need to consult with MODOT to determine whether the road is classified as a county road or a state highway. The Commission will follow up with Mr. Broughton after speaking with MODOT.




**ADJOURNMENT**
