CALDWELL COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

Tuesday, January 06, 2026

CALL TO ORDER

Presiding Commissioner Akey called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

AGENDA

Commissioner Hibler moved to approve the agenda. Commissioner Akey seconded the motion. Commissioner Akey, Commissioner Howell, and Commissioner Hibler voted in favor. The motion passed.

Commissioner Akey moved to approve the consent agenda. Commissioner Hibler seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Akey-yes; Commissioner Hibler-yes; Commissioner Howell-yes. The motion passed.

At 8:30 a.m. the Commission and Jeff Campbell, Road & Bridge Supervisor opened bids for the sale of a Road & Bridge dump truck. Phil Clevenger was present by phone. Three bids were submitted. The bids are as follows: Ryan Allsup \$1,660; Jason Rush \$3,000; City of Braymer \$3,525.50. Commissioner Hibler made a motion to accept the \$3,525.50 bid from City of Braymer. Commissioner Howell seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Akey-yes; Commissioner Hibler-yes; Commissioner Howell-yes. The motion passed.

The Commissioner and Jeff Campbell discussed debris remaining at the Little Otter Creek site, as well as the mulching of trees that have regrown.

Jeff Campbell reported that Green Hills would begin installation of additional fiber in Caldwell County.

The construction of James Bridge was discussed. It was noted that an email had been received from the contractor requesting a meeting with the Commission.


The Commissioners contacted Renee Anderson at Bank Northwest about the renewal of county certificates of deposit. The rate for six-month renewals is 3.5%.


The Commission met with Brady Kopeck, Prosecuting Attorney, to address questions regarding his 2026 budget.


ADJOURNMENT
