CALDWELL COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

Tuesday, February 03, 2026

CALL TO ORDER

Presiding Commissioner Akey called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

AGENDA

Commissioner Hibler moved to approve the agenda. Commissioner Howell seconded the motion. Commissioner Akey, Commissioner Howell and Commissioner Hibler voted in favor. The motion passed.

Commissioner Howell moved to approve the consent agenda. Commissioner Hibler seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Akey-yes; Commissioner Hibler-yes; Commissioner Howell-yes. The motion passed.

Sheriff Mitch Allen, Rich Smith, and Jessica Farmer gave a report on the Caldwell County Detention Center. They reported that two fire suppression panels must be replaced due to damage caused by a water leak. Replacement of a stove is also required. Low revenues in the Canteen Fund in 2025 were discussed.

Commissioner Dale Akey left the meeting at 9:00 a.m. to attend Great Northwest Days in Jefferson City.

Commissioners and Gabriela Gonzales, License Office Manager, conducted an interview for a part-time position in the License Office.

Commissioner Howell moved to enter closed session to discuss personnel matters, pursuant to Section 610.021(3) RSMo, and to close all records and votes, to the extent of

the law. Commissioner Hibler seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken, Commissioner Akey-absent; Commissioner Hibler-yes; Commissioner Howell-yes. The motion passed.

CLOSED SESSION

Commissioner Howell moved to exit closed session. Commissioner Hibler seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken, Commissioner Howell; Commissioner Hibler-yes; Commissioner Akey-absent. The motion passed.

The Emergency Management position was discussed. Commissioners reviewed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) from Green Hills Regional Planning Commission to provide local emergency management and floodplain administration services, including program administration, technical assistance, and management.

Commissioner Howell moved to approve and enter into the MOU with Green Hills Regional Planning Commission. Commissioner Hibler seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken Commissioner Hibler-yes; Commissioner Howell-yes; Commissioner Akey-absent. The motion passed.

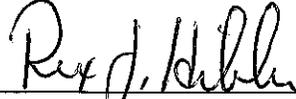

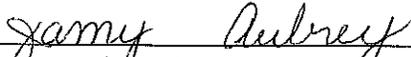

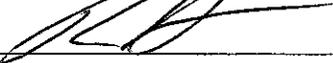
ADJOURNMENT
